This article offers a careful reading of the female banqueters depicted on this psykter to argue that the image had a variety of associations (female, Spartan, excess) for the ancient viewer, who was unlikely to view them as simply sex labourers at a symposium. It cautions against assigning a specific identity to female figures on Greek vases.
