This article discusses Roman coins characterized by what we might call “transgender motives” – types attributing to the represented personifications, persons and gods a different gender from the expected one. In particular, the article focuses on two emissions: Gallienus’ aurei on which the emperor is called in the feminine *Galliena Augusta* and a series of coins minted under Maximinus Daza in which the Sun god *Sol* is accompanied by the feminine attribute *invicta*.
