The space granted to Roman women in the civic and political spheres documented by epigraphy is linked to the actual or solicited possibility of their concrete intervention in favour of the city. It should be noted, however, that the communication of public intervention by a woman needs, in most cases, the already tried and tested channels of female representation in cities: the expression of traditional matronly virtues, worship and reference to a male kinship.
