Germanicus had at his side in his not long life some women who were described by Latin sources with essentially negative tones based on their behavior: his mother Antonia Minor, his wife Agrippina the Elder and his sister Claudia Livia Julia. In this paper I try to analyze the role of these female figures in Germanicus' life, and I try to understand the progressive construction of such negative judgements.
