This book chapter offers a new methodology for exploring the relationships and networks between women classicists at the turn of the twentieth century, as women were beginning to have more official access to classics as a subject and were beginning to develop the subject expertise they needed to teach in the all-women colleges that were starting to gain ground in the UK higher education landscape. It begins to uncover the complicated networks and arrangements through which women began to take ownership of classics and their identity as classicists.
