The paper deals with literary portraits of the Julio-Claudian women and, more specifically, relationships between women of different generation and in different family roles – mothers, daughters, grandmothers, mothers-in-law, daughters-in-law, sisters-in-law. The focus is on the relationship of Livia to the younger women of the family when they were already married wives and mothers, as described by ancient authors such as Tacitus, Suetonius and Cassius Dio.
