Drawn from texts in a variety of genres across four centuries, this selection of Latin readings plus commentary illuminates both historical and fictional women, of varying ages and different stages of life, from a range of social classes and different locales, some speaking in their own person and others portrayed by male authors. Distinctive in its foregrounding of women in explicitly erotic roles and its inclusion of literary works and inscriptions from archaic Latin, it encourages a variety of critical approaches.
