This *Guide to Latin Elegy and Lyric* focuses on the poetry of authors such as Catullus, Horace, Tibullus, Propertius, Ovid and Sulpicia, both for readers who know Latin and those who may not. The book includes information about each poet, an in-depth look at some of their poetry, and cultural and historical background. Included are discussions of themes, language and ideas in the poetry, modes of reception, major themes and critical approaches, in particular feminist theory. There are also chapters on How to Read a Latin Elegiac or Lyric Poem and How to Teach a Latin Elegiac and Lyric Poem.
