

**Carney, E. D., S. Müller (eds) (2021) *The Routledge Companion to Women and Monarchy in the Ancient Mediterranean World*, Routledge, Oxford and New York.**

This edited volume is the first to explore the role of women in monarchy around the ancient Mediterranean. It is divided into sections on Egypt and the Nile Valley, the ancient Near East, Greece and Macedonia, Commonalities (across multiple regions and periods), Rome from Republic to Empire, and one concerning the reception of the role of women in ancient monarchies. There are forty-one chapters in all.
